Is a leading research fellow and the head of the Department for Typology and Comparative Linguistics and the Center for Balkan Linguo-Cultural Studies at the Institute for Slavic Studies, Russian Academy of Sciences.

Her academic fields of study are Slavic and Balkan Linguistics (Ethnolinguistics, Dialectology, Lexicology, Language Contacts), Folklore, and Ethnology with special attention towards Bulgarian studies. She graduated from Moscow State University, and defended two dissertations on Bulgarian, South-Slavic, and Balkan ritual-year and life-cycle terminology, narratives, and customs. She has published two monographs and over 350 articles in 30 countries and has edited over 30 books and thematic issues of journals. She has participated in over 150 international and national conferences and congresses and is Secretary of Société Internationale d'Ethnologie et de Folklore (SIEF's) The Ritual Year Working Group (from 2004), and co-chair (from 2014).
