Is an Associate Professor at the Institute for Bulgarian Language „Prof. L. Andreychin”, BAS. She is a member of the Department of Ethnolinguistics, conducting research in the field of Ethnolinguistics, Cognitivism and Linguoculturology, related to the study of cultural phenomena of Bulgarian traditional culture, the stereotypes in the behavior of Bulgarians.

She is the author of two monographs: *Представата за ума в българската езикова картина за света* (The Mind in the Bulgarian Language Picture of the World, Sofia, 2017) and *Пастирската терминология в Софийско* (The Shepherds Terminology in the Sofia Region, 2011). Y. Kirilova is one of the co-authors of the great *Етнолингвистичен речник на българската народна медицина* (Ethnolinguistic Dictionary of Bulgarian Folk Medicine, AP „Prof. Marin Drinov”, 2021).
